Rep. Fritchey to Host Senior Town Hall Meeting *Topics to include avoiding senior fraud and identity theft*

Chicago – As part of his ongoing efforts to inform seniors about unscrupulous businesses and individuals, State Rep. John Fritchey (D-11) will be hosting a Senior Town Hall meeting on **Monday, September 15th**, to discuss information about various state resources available to assist seniors in avoiding fraud and identity theft.

“The unfortunate reality is there are more people than ever trying to take advantage of senior citizens, which endangers their personal and economic security,” stated Rep. Fritchey. “It is my hope that we can give our senior citizens information that will prevent them from becoming victims in the first place, or let them know where to turn to if they have already been targeted by crooks.”

The meeting will also be attended by a representative from Attorney General Lisa Madigan’s office to discuss programs and assistance dealing with senior fraud and identity theft.
